Magnet Netball Club Kit

A number of parents have approached us, asking about kit requirements. Just so you can be clear about what is needed, here is a list of what your daughter will need.

- **Trainers** are the most important purchase for your netball playing daughter, and as she progresses up through the club will be a significant purchase. Ensure, even from a young age, that they have arch support, not flat soles. Once your daughter is playing in matches, she must be wearing specialist netball shoes only.
- **Training Kit.** For all training sessions, your daughter should wear a navy skort, the blue Magnet Netball Club t-shirt (available from Thames Valley Sports), white socks & trainers. Magnet Netball Club hoodies are an optional purchase from the club.
- **Match Kit.** Year 5 wear training kit to matches. Year 6 have a purple Magnet Netball Club shirt for matches and tournaments, provided by the coach at matches. Year 7 and above wear the green & purple skirts and tops provided by the club for matches and tournaments. All girls playing in competition squads are encouraged to purchase the club hoody.

More information on the kit & what to buy is on the club website, or just ask your coach at training.
